

# Katonah Museum of Art



The KMA is happy to welcome families back to the Museum's Learning Center in a safe and fun way. **Admission is by advance reservation, with timed ticketing to ensure the comfort and safety of visitors and staff.** Timed tickets for the Learning Center will be available to small family groups (no more than four people) and must be reserved for the same time slot as your main Museum admission. You can sign up online for a time slot time and purchase a ticket to visit the KMA and add a reservation for the same time slot to the Learning Center where a maximum of two families can work at a time.

Upon check-in you will receive a Family Guide and activity pack with everything you need to enjoy your visit. The Family Guide will lead you through the *Bisa Butler: Portraits* exhibition with discussion prompts. Then you can go into the Learning Center which has been transformed by artist Tijay Mohammed with a site-specific installation that celebrates women. Using your Family Guide and activity pack you can create your own artwork inspired by the exhibitions. The Museum and Learning Center will be cleaned between each group of visitors. Don't forget the beauty of the Sculpture Garden where you can sit for a while at socially distanced tables and chairs and create your artwork outside. Members and children under 12 are always free. Masks are required for anyone over 2 years old.

Tickets will be sold one month at a time for the foreseeable future. Tuesdays through Saturdays from 10:00 – 11:15 AM and Sundays from 12:00 – 1:00 PM are reserved exclusively for populations at risk. Thank you for your support of the Katonah Museum of Art.
