



To High School Art Teachers,

We are looking forward to the Katonah Museum of Art's **Young Artists 2022: High School Art Exhibition**, now in its 39th year. The exhibition will be on view February 6 – February 27, 2022. We are excited that the program will move forward again this year, although some modifications and COVID-safe protocols will still be in place. In this packet you will find all the information needed for your school to participate. If you are new to the program or have any questions, we are happy to discuss at your convenience, just reach out to: madasko@katonahmuseum.org.

Young Artists gives high school students the opportunity to participate behind-the-scenes in many aspects of mounting a museum exhibition. The first component of this program is the **Graphic Design Workshop** in which students design the *Young Artists 2022* invitation. This year, the workshop will be slightly modified with both in-person and virtual components. On Monday, November 22, graphic design educators will lead a virtual presentation, which will introduce important graphic design concepts and outline the objectives of the postcard invitation design. Students will then attend an all-day, in-person design workshop on Monday, December 6 at the KMA, where they will complete their projects. The winning design will be selected from these submissions. In-person participants are required to have vaccination documentation or a negative COVID test within 72 hours. **Teachers should submit the names and emails of one or two seniors to participate in this workshop by Thursday, November 18.** Email the enclosed confirmation form to madasko@katonahmuseum.org.

In January and February, senior students' artwork is selected by teachers, framed, and delivered to the KMA for the exhibition. After the artwork is received, select students from each school participate in curating and installing the exhibition on two **Installation Days**, held at the KMA. All participants are required to have vaccination documentation or a negative COVID test within 72 hours. Artists, teachers, families, and friends are invited to the exhibition opening taking place on Sunday, February 6, 2022. All guests will be required to make advanced, timed-ticket reservations, and have proof of vaccination or negative COVID test within 72 hours of the event. The *Young Artists 2022* exhibition will be on view February 6 – 27.

To participate in *Young Artists 2022*, your school must pay the annual fee of \$275 for the KMA School Program. Please let us know if you would like an invoice sent to you. The KMA School Program also allows for unlimited virtual or in-person tours of KMA exhibitions. This year's exhibitions include *ARRIVALS* (on view through January 23) and *Constant Carnival: The Haas Brothers in Context* (March 13 – June 26, 2022)

YOUNG ARTISTS 2022 - Program Details
Exhibition Dates: February 6 – February 27, 2022

• **GRAPHIC DESIGN WORKSHOP:**

Teacher selects two seniors to participate in this workshop and send student names and emails by **Thursday, November 18**. Details will be sent to workshop participants.*

- **Monday, November 22, 7:00 -8:00 pm, Virtual Graphic Design Presentation:** Graphic Design Educators lead a virtual presentation, which will introduce important graphic design concepts and outline the objectives of the postcard invitation design.
- **Monday, December 6, 9-2:30, In-person Graphic Design Workshop.** Students attend an all-day design workshop at the KMA.
 - Students will prepare 3 design concepts to bring to the workshop
 - Students will have all day to complete 1 design and submit it to the contest.
 - In-person participants will need proof of vaccination or negative COVID test within 72 hours
 - Masks are required indoors.
- Designs will be voted on by participating students, KMA staff, Board, and volunteers to select a winning design to be used as the postcard invitation for *Young Artists 2022*.

* If students are unable to attend in-person, or have other conflicts, please contact Margaret Adasko to discuss other arrangements.

• **Week of December 6:**

- Paperwork for the exhibition, including consignment forms and labels, will be sent out to teachers by email (or mail, if requested.) The label information must be returned by Monday, January 24.

• **DELIVERY OF ARTWORK to KMA: Monday, January 31 and Tuesday, February 1, 1:00 – 5:00 pm** (or by appointment)

- Teachers deliver 10 artworks – one piece of art per senior. Sculpture, ceramics, mixed media, and video or media presentations are welcome.
- Art **MUST BE** framed, labeled, and ready to hang with all correct paperwork.

• **EXHIBITION INSTALLATION: Wednesday, February 2 and Thursday, February 3**

- Each school may choose up to four seniors or juniors to attend an installation time slot at KMA.
- Students will be introduced to exhibition design concepts in advance through a pre-recorded video.
- Hands-on installation of the exhibition artworks with guidance from professional installation staff will happen at KMA.
- COVID-19 safety protocols will be enforced:
 - Masks are required indoors.
 - Students must have proof of vaccination, or negative COVID test within 72 hours.

• **OPENING: Sunday, February 6**

- Artists, teachers, families and friends are invited to the opening celebration. All guests must reserve timed-entry tickets in advance and must have proof of vaccination, or negative COVID test with 72 hours of event.

• **Exhibition dates: Sunday, February 6 – Sunday, February 27, 2022**

- The Museum is free to all visitors throughout the exhibition. All guests must reserve timed-entry tickets in advance and must have proof of vaccination, or negative COVID test with 72 hours of visiting.

• **PICK UP ARTWORK: Monday, February 28 and Tuesday, March 1, 1:00 – 5:00 pm**
