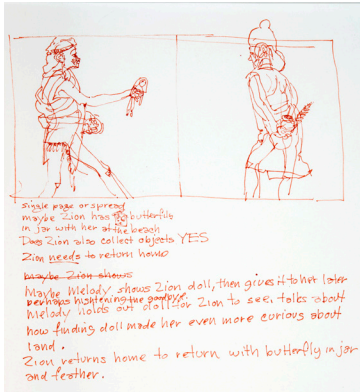


STORYBOARD YOUR BOOK
