

### **Visitor Code of Conduct**

By reserving your timed ticket, you agree to adhere to the Visitor Code of Conduct and to play your part in keeping the Museum safe for both visitors and staff.

# **Health and Safety**

The Museum is committed to keeping its visitors healthy and safe. We ask that each guest observe the following list of guidelines and policies.

- Proof of COVID-19 vaccination (ages 5+) and masks (ages 2+) are required for all visitors.
- Masks are required indoors for everyone over age 2, regardless of vaccination status.
- Outdoors, masks are optional for all.
- Hand sanitizer is available for your use when you enter the Museum and in the public areas.
- By purchasing tickets and entering the Museum, you are affirming that in the past 10 days you:
  - Have not had symptoms of COVID-19 or a positive COVID-19 test.
  - Have not been in close proximity to someone with confirmed or suspected COVID-19.
- The contact information you provided when purchasing your ticket will be used if we need to notify
  you of any COVID-19 exposure. Likewise, should you become ill with COVID-19 following your
  visit, please notify the Museum as soon as possible.
- Children under 2 years old are exempt from the face coverings requirement.
- Museum staff will be cleaning and disinfecting all high-touch surfaces with increased frequency throughout the day.

# **Social Distancing**

- Capacity is limited to 50 visitors per time slot.
- Please maintain six feet between yourself, other visitors, and Museum staff.

## **Safety Procedures**

The Museum is operated in accordance with guidelines established by New York State. We ask that you observe all signage and instructions at the Museum, and we reserve the right to ask anyone not following safety measures to leave the premises.

## Liability

By reserving tickets, you confirm that you are aware that visiting the Katonah Museum of Art includes risks arising from possible exposure to communicable diseases, including COVID-19. You knowingly and voluntarily accept this risk and assume full responsibility for any injury, illness, or other loss that you may sustain as a result.
