By reserving your timed ticket, you agree to adhere to the Visitor Code of Conduct and to play your part in keeping the Museum safe for both visitors and staff.

## Health and Safety

The Museum is committed to keeping its visitors healthy and safe. We ask that each guest observe the following list of guidelines and policies.

### Health and Safety

- Masks are required for all visitors (ages 2+), regardless of vaccination status.
- Outdoors, masks are optional for all. Hand sanitizer is available for your use when you enter the Museum and in the public areas.
- Children under 2 years old are exempt from the face coverings requirement.
