MUSEUMS

Museum and Garden Open from April to November

Hours: Wednesday-Sunday from 11:00 am-5:00 pm

Admission: \$12 for adults and kids; \$8 for seniors (65+), students with ID, and veterans; free for kids under the age of 5

This museum and garden are quite stunning during the spring and summer when you and your kids can stroll and soak in the beauty of its grounds. Located in South Salem, the garden is revealed as you walk through its 3.5-acre path, where you will see a pond, rare Japanese plants and trees, and species native to Westchester. There is also an on-site museum with various art exhibits.

Hours: Thursday-Saturday from 11:00 am-5:00 pm

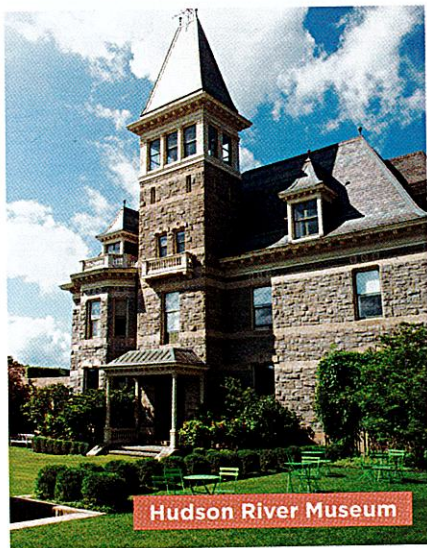
